Do wait for your turn to speak.

Don't interrupt others and **NEVER** speak when the Judge is

speaking.

Do listen carefully to the Judge's questions and answer them honestly.

Don't interrupt the Judge.

Do bring all necessary documents.

Don't bring your children to court. **Don't** try to bring your cell phone into the courthouse.

Do sit quietly at the courthouse while waiting

Don't participate in loud conversations.

Don't eat, drink or chew gum.
